Act of Faith

O my God, I firmly believe that You are in three divine Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. I believe that your divine Son became man and died for our sins, and that He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe these and all the truths which the Holy Catholic Church teaches. Because You have revealed them, who can neither deceive nor be deceived. Amen.

Act of Hope

O my God, relying in Your infinite goodness and promises, I hope to obtain pardon of my sins, the help of your grace and life everlasting through the merits of Jesus Christ, MY Lord and Redeemer. Amen.

Act of Love

O my God, I love You above all things, with my whole hearty and soul, because You are all good and worthy of all my love. I love my neighbor as myself for the love of You. I forgive all who have injured me, and I ask the pardon of all whom I have injured. Amen.

Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, one in Being with the Father. Through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven *(all bow during the following three lines)*: by the power of the Holy Spirit he was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered, died, and was buried. On the third day he rose again in fulfillment of the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Angelus

P: The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary

R: And she conceived of the Holy Spirit. (Hail Mary)

P: Behold the handmaid of the Lord

R: Be it done unto me according to your word. (Hail Mary)

P: And the Word was made flesh

R: And dwelt among us (Hail Mary)

Let us Pray: Pour forth we beseech you O Lord Your grace into our hearts. That we to whom the incarnation of Christ Your Son was made known by the message of an angel and by His passion and cross be brought the glory of His resurrection through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

Come Holy Spirit

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit, and they shall be created: And you will renew the face of the earth. O God, on the first Pentecost you instructed the hearts of those who believe in you by the light of the Holy Spirit: Under the inspiration of the same Spirit, give us a taste of what is right and true and a continuing sense of His joy-bringing presence and power through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Litany

A Liturgical form of prayer consisting of a series of invocations where responses are the same for a number in succession. For example: during the Feast of all Saints Liturgy (P: St. Dominic R: Pray for us P: St. Catherine R: Pray for us..... R: all holy men and women pray for us)

Novena

A prayer which is said for nine days.
